

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on May 21, 2026, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the “Code”) will be held by the California Enterprise Development Authority (the “Authority”) at which the Authority will hear and consider information concerning the issuance, from time to time, pursuant to a plan of finance, of one or more series of tax-exempt and/or taxable revenue obligations by the Authority in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$8,500,000 (the “Revenue Obligations”). The proceeds of the Revenue Obligations will be used to make a loan to Herald Christian Health Center, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (the “Borrower”). The Borrower is an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. A portion of the proceeds of the loan in an amount not to exceed \$4,500,000 (the “San Diego Revenue Obligations”) will be applied to: (1) finance, refinance and/or reimburse the cost of acquisition, construction, improvement, installation, equipping and furnishing of health care facilities located at 7808 Clairemont Mesa Boulevard, San Diego, California 92111 (collectively, the “Facilities”); (2) fund interest on the San Diego Revenue Obligations; and (3) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the San Diego Revenue Obligations. The Facilities will be owned and operated by the Borrower.

The remaining proceeds of the Revenue Obligations will be applied to finance, refinance and/or reimburse the cost of acquisition, construction, improvement, installation, equipping and furnishing of health care facilities located at 3401 Aerojet Avenue, El Monte, California 91731. The Borrower will be seeking a separate public approval from the City of El Monte for the remaining \$4,000,000 of Revenue Obligations for the project located in the City of El Monte.

The Revenue Obligations to be issued pursuant to Section 145 of the Code, the obligation to pay principal of and interest thereon, and any redemption premium with respect thereto, do not constitute indebtedness or an obligation of the County of San Diego, the Authority, the State of California or any political subdivision thereof, within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory debt limitation, or a charge against the general credit or taxing powers of any of them. The Revenue Obligations shall be a limited obligation of the Authority, payable solely from certain revenues duly pledged therefore and generally representing amounts paid by the Borrower.

The hearing will be held by teleconference and will commence at 12:30 p.m. Pacific Time. Those wishing to comment on the proposed financing and/or refinancing and the nature and location of the Facilities and the financing and/or refinancing of the Facilities with the proceeds of the San Diego Revenue Obligations may access the teleconference by dialing (888) 788-0099 and entering conference ID number 285 326 8731 and participant passcode number 594902.
